Those early Sunday Schools were characterized by several traits: They used paid teachers. (Tease: wouldn't you Sunday School teachers like to get paid?)

They taught secular courses.

They taught mainly poor children.

Over the years Sunday School has evolved into what we know today. Rather than teaching reading and math to children, it is now an organization that focuses on teaching the Word of God to adults as well as children.
