Have you noticed how all creation seems to be alive? Spring brings out our creation in its splendor. Fittingly, it reminds me of the resurrection.

When Jesus was comforting Martha after the death of her brother, Lazarus, he said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die." Martha believed these words as she responded, "Yes, Lord, I believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, who is to come into the world." John 11:26, 27 And then after going to the tomb where Lazarus lay, Jesus wept. Jesus, the Son of God; Jesus, the Good Shepherd; Jesus, the Resurrection and Life; Jesus, full of compassion, wept.

With this, Jesus set the stage for his own death and resurrection. On the cross, he again would shed tears of sorrow and grief, but this time not for a friend, but for a lost and dying world. For we who believe, the glory of God comes through Jesus' resurrection. This is the story of Easter, to believe Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life.

May this Easter have an extra special meaning as we gather in the Light of the Resurrected One and the Hope that comes from our Redeemer.
