Another new year is upon us. While none of us know what circumstances we will experience in 2023,we do know that God is in control even when the world seems to be out of control. Let's look at two scriptures from the letters of Paul in which he admonishes his readers to remember the suffering of Christ, how they may be called to suffer as well, and how their suffering will increase their faith and develop them into proper citizens prepared for heaven.

Philippians 1:27-30 ²⁷"Above all, you must **live as citizens of heaven, conducting yourselves in a manner worthy of the Good News about Christ.** Then, whether I come and see you again or only hear about you, I will know that you are standing together with one spirit and one purpose, fighting together for the faith, which is the Good News. ²⁸ Don't be intimidated in any way by your enemies. This will be a sign to them that they are going to be destroyed, but that you are going to be saved, even by God himself. ²⁹ For you have been given not only the privilege of trusting in Christ but also the privilege of suffering for him. ³⁰ We are in this struggle together. You have seen my struggle in the past, and you know that I am still in the midst of it." (NLT)

Galatians 2:20 ²⁰ "My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." (NLT)

These words challenged his original audience and continue to challenge present day readers to understand that everything we do should represent the Kingdom of God and the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Don't get me wrong, Paul's first priority is for all to come to a saving knowledge of Jesus as Lord and Savior. But he also sees the big picture, life goes on AFTER repentance and renewal. That's his focus in these (and many other) passages. We are renewed and we should live as such. We are now to live as one who is worthy to spend eternity with the King.

As a minister, I can tell you that seeing God use people who have adjusted their lives for the purpose of God's agenda is one of the many blessing I have received through the years. I've known some who have made a complete surrender to the call of Christ and put off the "Old Self". Most transformations however, come from those who simply rededicate their lives to live in closer fellowship and discipleship with Christ. No matter the case, they have allowed their lives to be "worthy of the gospel."

The new year is a good time to re-evaluate your individual relationship with Jesus and the body of believers as a whole. Examine each aspect through the lens of doing it for the glory of God. What changes in your priorities or commitments are needed? In what area do you need to be more disciplined? As you adjust your life to God, realizing He is guiding and directing, you will begin receiving His blessings which give a greater sense of peace and joy. As a whole, the body will be raised up in victory as we receive God's amazing grace at work in the life of the church.
